- ✓ between the forest managers and forest owners, and the contractor, for defining the specifications (*cahier des charges*)
- ✓ Between the contractor and the carpenter ,to respect the technological requirements of these local Mediterranean timber

Need for a local emulation/local will around a development project (eg. Timber construction)

Promoting local employment and consolidating the net of timber processing companies in a short-circuit system (*“local timber-local companies-local construction”*)
